## POINTS OF ADVENTURE

- 1 Dune Ferry Pier**  
The perfect starting point along the wintry trail on Dune.
- 2a South Beach Adventure Trail**  
Take a stroll on the beach whilst experiencing the fascinating birth of seals.
- 2b Cemetery of the Nameless**  
As an alternative route to the South Beach adventure trail, you can take paved paths to the Cemetery of the Nameless and experience a piece of the island's exciting history first hand.
- 3 Dune Restaurant**  
Potentially only open around new year's in winter. Please refer to current notices for the exact opening times.
- 4 Jonnys Hill**  
The lookout point atop the hill in the heart of Dune provides a unique wintry view of the island.
- 5 Golf Pond**  
The freshwater pond offers quiet moments and even in winter from time to time glimpses into the fascinating bird life on Heligoland.
- 6 Airport**  
The airport restaurant with a shop offers a small selection of food and beverages. Open daily from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Please note the special holiday opening hours.
- 7 Northeast Lookout Point**  
Photographers, in particular, will love the idea of being able to capture the seal motifs of the north beach from a perspective close to the ground.
- 8 Panorama Trail**  
The wooden plank path on the crest of the dunes of north beach is particularly popular with families, as the beach and the rearing of young animals and bull fights can be observed from an elevated perspective.
- 9 North Lookout Point**  
Experience the grey seals on the north beach from a perspective close to the ground. The lookout point is ideally suitable for nature photographers.
- 10 Exhibition**  
The new exhibition in the pier building rounds off the route and provides an opportunity to read up on some information about the marine mammals whilst you wait for the Dune Ferry.
